### **Tiger® Brand Trucks/Vans Now on GSA Schedule**

**3 April 2009** – Poteau, OK – The General Services Administration (GSA) completed an agreement with Tiger Truck for its Tiger® branded vehicles to be made available under GSA Schedule 78. This action will permit federal agencies and departments, certain government contractors, and other designated entities to buy through the GSA at pre-negotiated best prices.

“Government buyers now have this convenient acquisition path made available to them,” said Mike Felder, Tiger’s Chief Operating Officer. “We have been aware of the growing pent-up demand for our strong products. This action is particularly timely as the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) provides real impetus to upgrade federal fleets with efficient alternative energy vehicles. Our assembly operation here in Poteau is prepared to meet this mounting demand as fleet managers increasingly replace conventional gas-guzzlers with more efficient vehicles, like ours.”

This strong line of small trucks and vans are assembled in Tiger’s plant in Oklahoma and are compliant with the Trade Agreements Act. TAA-compliance is a requirement for being listed on the GSA Schedule. Any of Tiger’s vehicles may be powered by E85 FlexFuel, electric drive (48V or 72V) or EFI gasoline.

By virtue of the U.S. assembly operation that it can directly control, the Tiger® brand vehicles enjoy substantial advantages, among them:

- All metal frame, bed, and body parts are cleaned and prepared using state-of-the-art cathodic electrocoating; then are finished with a baked powder-paint coat prior to assembly. This advanced process by PPG yields the most durable finish in the automotive industry.
- Improvements developed by Tiger engineering are incorporated at various stages of assembly.
- Seats are built-up using extra foam padding and covered with a superior rip-stop, non-allergenic fabric more commonly used in long-haul overland trucks for both comfort and a rugged long life.

- Each vehicle is quality-checked at critical stages of assembly with results documented and archived.
- Tiger® brand vehicles carry an extended two-year limited warranty.
